On Sunday, June 14, our Nation's Flag Day, the Christian County Elks #2777 hosted two impressive ceremonies. The first ceremony took place in the lodge room for Flag Day, led by Exalted Ruler Charles Falzone. Charlie opened the open meeting with a brief description and purpose of Flag Day. Past Exalted Ruler, Scotty Butler, then gave the guests a detailed presentation about the history of the American flag. As each flag entered the lodge room, the flag history was introduced and a scout from Troop 201 presented the flag of that era. ER Falzone then called on Leading Knight, Scotty Butler PER, Loyal Knight, Tom Shelton PSP, Lecturing Knight Charlie Hopkins and Lodge Esquire, Jan Bruenger to read important purpose and the meaning of our flag. Lodge Chaplin, Mary Angell, lead us in prayer at the opening and ending of the ceremony. At the ending of the ceremony, Lodge Esquire, Jan Bruenger, passed on the soiled and retired flags to a scout member making the flags now ready for the ceremonial burning. The Christian County Elks Flag Day ceremony was attended by 20 Elks and 23 Scouts and their leaders. All In attendance then left the lodge room and worked their way to the outdoor pavilion area where the Scouts and leaders would retire 28 flags in ceremony number two.

Elks flag retirement ceremony was part two of Flag Day June 14th. Taking place at the Christian County Elks outdoor pavilion, 23 scouts and their leaders performed the ceremonial retirement of 28 flags. A scout member read to the guests the purpose of burning of flags in the retirement process. Each flag was then gently placed in the fire pit and burned to ashes as everyone saluted. All grommets are removed and will be handed out to veterans at future ceremonies. Any retired or worn-out flag can be dropped off at any Elks Lodge in the country and the Elks will take the responsibility of proper retirement of that flag. 
