Big thanks to our Elks who participated in Wreaths Across America for our fallen Veteran members.







Holiday Boutique



As we start the new year, we can look back on the improvements that have been made in our kitchen. They have all been made with the best interest of the Lodge in mind. We still have farther to go. Our goal is to provide the best possible meal at the lowest price. One area we need to improve on is the amount of food prepared. We would like to be able to feed everyone and have no leftovers. In most cases that is not possible, but we need to try. To accomplish this, we are looking at a few changes to the way things have been done. One possible improvement we are looking at is taking reservations for Steak Nite. This would allow us to purchase only the product needed, keeping costs down. During the month when the cashier is taking money for the current meal, they would also be taking reservations the next Steak Nite. Reservations would need to be paid for at the time made. Reservations could be made up to the Friday before Steak Nite. That would allow us to purchase and prepare only what is needed and will also help us better manage seating arrangements. Please pass your comments on to any Lodge officer.

Another area we need assistance with is kitchen cleanup after meals. Currently, the cooking crew is not only preparing meals but doing the kitchen cleanup too. We would like to have organized cleanup crews that could take care of the after-meal cleanup. It is not hard, and we have a commercial dishwasher/sanitizer.
